#### **The EMPLOYS Project**

This collaborative partnership aims at improving good governance in the employment relations of athletes in Olympic sports by providing, evaluating and sharing evidence based information, practices and recommendations in an important subdomain of sport and governance. The project team will provide evidence based policy recommendations for sport governing bodies from the local to the global level as well as for national public authorities and EU institutions. The project is structured around three specific goals:

- Understanding establishing an evidence base of the legal and socio-political landscape defining the employment relations of athletes in Olympic sports in 29 European countries and the European Union;
- Evaluating assessing the current practice across the continent;
- Improving formulating and implementing concrete policy recommendations for key stakeholders.

The focus of the event is on two dimensions of employment relations: income and commercial opportunities, particularly in the context of Eastern Europe.

Participation is available onsite and online. The venue is located in Rondo 1 tower (Rondo ONZ 1) in the city center of Warsaw, right next to the Rondo ONZ metro station.
